As textile printers we use slightly different methods than shown on the course itself, ie: there is no snap involved, you do not prime the mesh but make multiple passes so the dyes "penetrates into the material to make it long lasting and durable. We do not use inks but acid reactive dyes.

Slightly different to what was covered in the course work. However I have learned a lot over the past 2 months and feel i can take a lot of the information forward.

I finished the final test last night and scored 97% i was pretty chuffed with that considering i didn't print out the test sheets as I could have done.

Final comments, As you said, take time to read through everything at least twice, you have plenty of time so use it.
